

DECISION

of Central Election Commission of the Republic of Azerbaijan on consideration of the appeal # 74 submitted to the Central Election Commission on September 10, 2024 in the Elections to the Milli Majlis on September 1, 2024

Regarding the Elections to the Milli Majlis on September 1, 2024, Mireli Nurlan Sabir registered candidates from Nasimi-Binagadi Con.EC #21 from Musavat Party applied to the Central Election Commission of the Republic of Azerbaijan (CEC) on September 8, 2024 challenged decision #34/83, and claiming that the law violations were committed in polling stations of that Con.EC, therefore requested to undertake relevant measures and voting of the results for that Con.EC requested to cancel.

The appeal was adopted for the implementation in comply with Articles 112 and 112-1 of the Election Code of the Republic of Azerbaijan (Election Code) and relevant opinion was provided on filing the appeal upon violating the rules for destination by a member of the Expert Group under CEC and considered at the Commission session.

Registered candidate for deputy G.G.Aslanli who applied on Voting day , there were total violations Nasimi-Binagadi Con.EC #21 in all polling stations of the constituency, during the organization of the precinct election commission and Con.EC#37 violation of the requirement of Article 36.2, 20 January street 28, 30, 34, 34A, 36, 40 addresses all belongs to the Nasimi-Yasamal Con.EC #22, after drawing up the protocols on the voting results given to election subjects, voting results claiming that the 3rd copy of the protocol does not hang in the information posts, and demanded the cancellation of the voting results in the same polling stations. The applicant in his appeal protocols added electronic information on some polling stations and video footage. Participation of the applicant in the investigation and the meeting of the Central Election Commission was ensured.

Thus, due to the fact that there are no legal grounds for granting the application of the candidate G.G.Aslanli the application should not be granted, and the Decision #34/83 dated September 8, 2024 of the Constituency Election Commission should be kept unchanged.

In connection with the investigation, the relevant documents were taken from the Con. EC it has been added to its materials and G.G.Aslanli 's Investigation and appeal on the voting day in connection with violations of the law in the polling stations of the constituency the images posted on social networks covered materials and others presented by the candidate .

During the complete, comprehensive and objective investigation conducted with the participation of the complainant, registered candidate from the Musavat Party G.G. Aslanli at the Central Election Commission, relevant election subjects for the polling stations disputed by the candidate, including observers who observed the voting process in those polling stations on the voting day, chairmen and secretaries of precinct election commissions, members, the violations alleged in the explanations given by the

other registered candidate were not confirmed. To determine the will of the voters at the polling stations during the examination of the submitted video images

In addition, during the organization of precinct election commissions in 37 polling stations, it is determined from the references submitted for investigation by the relevant state body regarding the alleged violation of the requirements of Article 36.2 of the Election Code that the members of the contested polling station precinct election commissions live permanently in the territory of Nasimi-Binagadi Con.EC #. 21.

Regarding the claim that the addresses 28, 30, 34, 34A, 36, 40 of 20 Janvar Street belong to the boundaries of Nasimi-Yasamal electoral district No. 22, it should be noted that these addresses are included in the boundaries of polling station No. 6 of Nasimi-Binagadi electoral district No. 21.

As a part of the investigation, the protocols of the disputed precinct election commissions on the voting results were received from the constituency election commission and reviewed.

As a result of a comparative examination of the 26 protocol copies submitted by the applicant with the information contained in the official protocols, the information on 25 protocols was identical. No. 30 while researching the data on the polling station, inconsistencies were found that did not allow determining the will of the voters in one way or another. Indicated violations election legal grounds for invalidating the results of voting on polling station No. 30 have arisen since it created a basis for invalidating the results of voting on polling stations according to the requirements of the legislation.

Thus, the appeal of Aslanli Gulaga Gulam oglu should be partially granted, the results of the voting at the polling station No. 30 should be considered invalid, the Decision No. 34/83 of the District Election Commission dated September 8, 2024 should be canceled in the part on the polling station No. 30, and the remaining parts should not be changed must be maintained.

Based on the above, the Central Election Commission Election according to Articles 19.4, 28.2, 112, 112-1 of the Code decides:

1. The appeal No. 74 dated September 10, 2024 of the registered candidate from the Musavat Party Aslanli Gulaga Gulam oglu in Nasimi-Binagadi Con.EC # 21 in the early elections to the Milli Majlis of the Republic of Azerbaijan held on September 1, 2024 should be partially granted, the results of the voting at the polling station No. 30 should be considered invalid.

2. Decision No. 34/83 of the District Election Commission of Nasimi-Binagadi Con.EC #21, dated September 8, 2024, should be canceled in the part of polling station No. 30, and kept unchanged in other parts.

1. The decision shall be enforced upon its publication.
